use labels to provide context

DON'T use defaults

- order your data
- **DON'T** misrepresent your data
- D0 use color to call attention
- DON'T use visuals for visual sake ✓ DO pay attention to alignment
- **DON'T** use diagonal text
- **D** be specific to your audience
